

# Crochet Chicken

Easy

200 grams / 7 oz yarn

Hook recommended by yarn

Yarn needle and scissors

1 stitch marker or tiny scrap of yarn

A scrap of Orange, red and black yarn for

face and comb.

Toy stuffing

US Crochet Terms Used



**NOTE: This project is worked in a spiral. There is no joining at the end of the round. On each round, replace the stitch marker into the 1st stitch.**

1. Holding 2 strands of yarn together, ch4, join with a slip stitch to the first chain. 12 sc into the ring DO NOT JOIN.
2. Single crochet into the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch, place marker into the stitch you just made, sc into the same stitch, 2sc into each stitch around.
3. 1 sc into the first stitch, place a stitch marker into the stitch just made. \*2sc into the next stitch, 1sc into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around.
4. \*1sc into the next 2 stitches, 2sc into the next\* repeat from \* to \* around.
5. Sc into each round for another 12 rounds, do not cut yarn

Your project will now look like a hat, close the opening.

Leave a tail of yarn that is twice the width of the opening, cut your yarn.



Sew up  $\frac{3}{4}$  the way across, then stuff your chicken with toy stuffing, close up the rest of the row.

Comb

Chose the end that you want to be the chicken face

Attach red yarn 5 stitches from the end, crochet towards the end, ch2, 4 dc into the same stitch, into the next 4 stitches. Slip stitch into the last stitch. Sew in your ends.

Stitch on face and an X for a butt.
