2 balls of [Magic Light Ice yarn in the rainbow colourway](#)

5.5 mm/I hook

Scissors, measuring tape and yarn needle

A couple of stitch markers <https://amzn.to/3LZJhdY>

1. Foundation single crochet until your row is 30 inches long.
Making sure your row isn't twisted, slip stitch to the first foundation single crochet to join.
2. Ch 1, (3 sc, ch 1) into the same stitch. *Skip 3 stitches, (3 hdc, ch 1) into the 4th chain* repeat from * to * to the end of the round. **DO NOT JOIN or TURN.**
3. Make sure your work is not twisted. (3 hdc, ch 1) into the **top of the first sc** from round 2. *(3 hdc, ch 1) into the next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * to end of the round.
4. *(3 hdc, ch1) into the next ch 1 space* repeat for the remainder of the project until you are 3 rounds short of the length you would like.

The next 3 rounds are optional.

If you do not want to do this step, skip it 😊

3hdc into the next ch 1 space repeat from * to * for another 3 rounds

To neaten off, work 1 round of single crochet.

Sew the first round together and sew in ends.
