USA terminology



Red heart super saver – I have used turqua and frosty green

I made a baby size and used 100gm / 3.5 oz of turqua and almost 200 grams / 7 oz of frosty green

Scissors

Yarn needle

Ch 4 and join or Magic circle

1. Ch 3 (counts as first stitch) 15 dc into ring, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3
2. Ch 3, 4 dc into same stitch, skip a stitch \*5 dc into next, skip a stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3 – you will have 8 shells
3. Slip stitch into next stitch, ch 3, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next stitch, skip 2 dc \*1 dc into next stitch, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next stitch, skip 2 stitches\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3
4. Slip stitch into next stitch, ch 3, 1 dc into the next stitch, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 2 stitches, skip 2 dc \*1 dc into next 2 stitches, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 2 stitches, skip 2 stitches\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3
5. Slip stitch into next stitch, ch 3, 1 dc into the next 2 stitches, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 3 stitches, skip 2 dc \*1 dc into next 3 stitches, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 3 stitches, skip 2 stitches\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3
6. Slip stitch into next stitch, ch 3, 1 dc into the next 3 stitches, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 4 stitches, skip 2 dc \*1 dc into next 4 stitches, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 4 stitches, skip 2 stitches\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3
7. Slip stitch into next stitch, ch 3, 1 dc into the next 4 stitches, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 5 stitches, skip 2 dc \*1 dc into next 5 stitches, 5 dc into next stitch (this will be the middle stitch of the 5 dc from previous round) dc into the next 5 stitches, skip 2 stitches\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch

Continue increasing the same way we have been in previous rows ☺ Sew in ends
