US Terminology



Yarn can be purchased here - https://www.facebook.com/groups/1058957830792602/

100 grams 8ply/DK yarn approx. 220m

4.5mm hook

Yarn needle and scissors

- Ch 3 can be used instead of the ch 2
- 1. MC, ch 2, 2 dc, turn
- 2. Ch 2, dc into same stitch, place stitch marker on the ch 2 you just made, dc into the remaining stitches, turn
- 3. Ch 2, dc into NEXT stitch and each stitch across, turn
- 4. The stitch marker is now on the right hand side, every time you at the beginning of the row when you stitch marker is on the right hand side, you know that this row is an INCREASE row ch 2, dc into same stitch, dc into each stitch across don't forget the last stitch (this is the turning chain from the previous row)
- 5. Repeat 3 and 4 for the length of your shawl or until your yarn runs out  $\ensuremath{\textcircled{\sc o}}$

Sew in ends
