

# BLANKET SIZES



These sizes are a guide ☺

- Blankets can be made in so many different sizes and sometimes it is hard to know what size to make. I have put together a blanket size guide and hopefully this gives you an idea on how big you want to make your project
- If you are making blankets for preemies to newborns, blankets without holes are best because their tiny fingers will go through the holes
- Small Preemie: 18" - 20"/45 cm - 50 cm square
- Medium Preemie: 20" - 22"/50 cm - 56 cm square
- Large Preemie: 22" - 30"/55 cm - 75 cm square
- Full Term Baby: 32" - 36"/80 cm - 90 cm square
- Baby: 30" - 36"/75 cm - 90 cm square
- Children 42" - 48"/106 cm - 121 cm square
- Lapghan often used in seniors homes 36" x 48"/90 cm - 121 cm square
- Adult Afghan (Will fit across top of bed) 48" x 72" - twin sized
- Adult Double Bed (Will fit across top of bed and over just a bit) 60" x 84"

## **Burial baby blankets**

- These are best made in white or cream
- NO BRIGHT COLOURS - NO HOLES - SOFT yarn is a must !
- 14 – 20 weeks gestation – 12"/30cm square
- 20 – 25 weeks gestation -15"/40cm square
