Yarn and recommended crochet hook

Scissors

Yarn needle

Make a Magic ring.

1: *Ch 4, 5TR, Ch4 slip stitch into ring* Repeat *to* once. Tighten Magic ring a little bit.

2: Ch4, turn bow over and slip stitch into the base of the middle TR. Ch4, Sk 3 stitches, slip stitch into Magic ring (between the “petals” of the bow) Ch4, Slip stitch into the base of the middle TR on this side, Ch4, slip stitch into first ch.

Close magic ring fully, Fasten off and change colour.

With the bow facing you attach new colour with a slip stitch into one of the Ch4 spaces.

3: Ch3, 2DC Ch1, 2DC into Ch4 space, *3DC, Ch1, 3DC into next space* Repeat *to* 2 more times. Slip stitch into top of ch3 to join.

4: Slip stitch into next 2 stitches and into the ch1 space, Ch3, 2DC Ch1, 2DC, into ch1 space, 3DC into next space, *3DC, Ch1, 3DC into next ch1 space, 3DC into next space* Repeat *to* 2 more times slip stitch into top of ch3 to join.

Fasten off and sew in ends OR you can keep making the granny square part as large as you like.
