

Cable scarf or blanket Designed by Clare Sullivan Video tutorial -<u>https://youtu.be/HYBpwYGvpSc</u> US terminology DK/8ply yarn and a 4mm/G crochet hook Worsted weight/10ply – Red heart super saver – 5.5mm/l hook



Blanket is made using 5 strands of worsted weight/10ply – Red heart super saver and a 15mm hook Scissors, yarn needle and tape measure

## Multiple of 14+6

- 1. Dc into the 4<sup>th</sup> ch form the hook, dc across, turn
- 2. Ch 2, fpdc into next 2 stitches, dc into the next 4 stitches, skip 2 stitches, 1 fptr around the next 2 stitches, 1 fptr around the first skipped stitch, 1 fptr around the 2<sup>nd</sup> skipped stitch, dc into the next 4 stitches \*fpdc into the next 2 stitches, dc into the next 4 stitches, skip 2 stitches, 1 fptr around the next 2 stitches, 1 fptr around the first skipped stitch, 1 fptr around the 2<sup>nd</sup> skipped stitch, dc into the next 4 stitches\* repeat across until you have 3 stitches left, , fpdc into next 2 stitches, dc into last stitch
- Ch 2, bpdc around next 2, dc into the next 4 stitches, bpdc around next 4 stitches, dc into the next 4 stitches
  \*bpdc into the next 2 stitches, dc into the next 4 stitches, bpdc around next 4 stitches, dc into the next 4 stitches\*
  repeat across until you have 3 stitches left, bpdc into next 2 stitches, dc into last stitch
- 4. Repeat 2 and 3 and finish on a row 3
