US terminology

Easy

2 x Red Heart Soft in cherry red

9mm / M hook

Scissors and yarn needle

Cluster V stitch

Yarn over, go into stitch, pull thru loop, yarn over, pull thru 2, yarn over, go into same stitch, pull up loop, yarn over, pull thru 2, yarn over, pull thru 3, ch 1, yarn over and go into same stitch, pull up loop, yarn over, pull thru 2, yarn over and go into same stitch, pull up loop, yarn over, pull thru 2, yarn over pull thru 3

Holding 2 strands together

1. Ch multiple of 3, I did 18 ch's, this gives you 3 lots of cluster V stitch groups, if you want your project wider, add more chains 😊

Cl V stitch into the 6th ch from the hook *skip 2 ch's and work a cl V stitch into the next ch* repeat from * to * across, 1 dc into last ch, turn

2. From now on we will be working our cl V stitches into the ch 1 space
Ch 3, * cl V stitch into the ch 1 space* repeat from * to * across and dc into the last ch, turn

Repeat row 2 for the remainder of the project - I made my scarf 150 cm / 63 inches long

Sew in ends
