Red heart super saver

5.5mm / H hook

Yarn needle

**Scissors** 

Fdc – foundation double crochet

Fpdc – front post double crochet

**Small Cosy** 

- 1. Fdc in multiples of 10 long enough to go loosely around the bottom of your cup DO NOT STRETCH!! Join to the top of the 1<sup>st</sup> dc
- Follow chart BUT YOU NEED TO SKIP THE FIRST ROUND (PLAIN FPDC) AND GO STRAIGHT INTO THE PATTERN - Follow chart from bottom to top, right to left

Medium length

- 1. Fdc in multiples of 10 long enough to go loosely around the bottom of your cup DO NOT STRETCH!! Join to the top of the 1<sup>st</sup> dc
- 2. Follow chart from bottom to top, right to left

Long length

- 1. Fdc in multiples of 10 long enough to go loosely around the bottom of your cup DO NOT STRETCH !! Join to the top of the  $1^{st}$  dc
- 2. Ch 2 (does not count as a stitch) fpdc around chain 3 and dc from the round below, fpdc around each stitch, Join to top of first dc
- 3. Follow chart from bottom to top, right to left
