



## Valentines cup cosy

Red heart super saver

5.5mm / H hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

Fdc – foundation double crochet

Fpdc – front post double crochet

You will need to use the graph shown in this pattern <http://www.myhobbyiscrochet.com/2014/12/a-hat-with-love-free-crochet-pattern.html>

### Small Cosy

1. Fdc in multiples of 10 - long enough to go loosely around the bottom of your cup DO NOT STRETCH !! Join to the top of the 1<sup>st</sup> dc
2. Follow chart BUT YOU NEED TO **SKIP THE FIRST ROUND** (PLAIN FPDC) AND GO STRAIGHT INTO THE PATTERN - Follow chart from bottom to top, right to left

### Medium length

1. Fdc in multiples of 10 - long enough to go loosely around the bottom of your cup DO NOT STRETCH !! Join to the top of the 1<sup>st</sup> dc
2. Follow chart from bottom to top, right to left

### Long length

1. Fdc in multiples of 10 - long enough to go loosely around the bottom of your cup DO NOT STRETCH !! Join to the top of the 1<sup>st</sup> dc
2. Ch 2 (does not count as a stitch) fpdc around chain 3 and dc from the round below, fpdc around each stitch, Join to top of first dc
3. Follow chart from bottom to top, right to left
