

## Cosy Headband

Red heart super saver – 50 grams in total Colours uses, turqua, shocking pink, bright yellow and pumpkin

5.5 mm / I hook Scissors Yarn needle

Foundation double crochet video tutorial

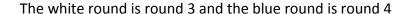

You can substitute the fpdc (front post double crochet) for a fptrc (front post treble crochet)

With your edging colour

- 1. Make an EVEN amount of foundation dc as many as you need to get the head measurement (crochet stretches and I make mine 2.5cm/1inch smaller than measurement) join with a slip stitch to the top of the chain 3
- 2. Ch 2, fpdc around the ch 3 of the previous round, ch 1 \*skip a dc and fpdc around the next, ch 1\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the first fpdc, finish off and sew in ends

- 3. Join new colour into the top of the fpdc, ch 1 \*fpdc around the unworked dc of round 1, ch 1\* repeat around join with a slip stitch to the top of the first fpdc, finish off and sew in ends
- 4. Join new colour into the top of the fpdc, ch 1 \*fpdc around the fpdc 2 rounds below (see pic) ch 1\* repeat around when you get to your last fpdc, make sure you put your fpdc around the ch 2 AND the fpdc join with a slip stitch to the top of the first fpdc, finish off and sew in ends





5. Repeat round 4 for as many colours as you like

Edging

Join colour into top of fpdc

6. Ch 1, hdc into same stitch \*fpdc around front post dc 2 rounds below, hdc into the top (under loops) of the fpdc\* \* repeat around join with a slip stitch to the top of the first hdc, finish off and sew in ends
