Material

8ply/Double Knit/Sports weight Yarn OR you can substitute this with worsted weight yarn
Crochet Hook - 6.0 mm
Scissors
Credit card
Yarn Needle

Notes: I made this pattern using 2x 8ply/Double Knit/Sports weight strands of yarn held together. You can substitute this with 1 strand of worsted weight yarn. This is an easy pattern and can be adjusted to fit different items

Pattern:

With 2 strands of 8ply/sports weight yarn held together OR 1 strand of worsted weight, Chain 10 or the width that you want your purse

R1: Ch 2 (counts as a stitch) half double crochet in the 3rd ch from the hook, half double crochet across

R2: Ch 2 (counts as a stitch) turn, half double crochet across

R3: Ch 2 (counts as a stitch) turn, half double crochet across

R4-R26: Same as R3 – you can adjust the amount of rows you make to suit the size you want
Leaving a 12 inch strand of yarn finish off

Directions:

You will now have a rectangle. Fold over ends (starting row and last row) to form the pockets – see image at start of pattern. Sew sides to create the pockets
