<u>Materials</u>

Yarn in two different colours, one for the cake and one for the topping

Crochet hook recommended for yarn

Scissors and yarn needle



US Stitches used

ch - chain sl st - slip stitch

hdc - half double crochet blo - back loops only

dc - double crochet flo - front loops only

Row 1: Chain 2 (counts as 1st stitch) 11 hdc into the first chain. SI st to beg ch.

Row 2: Ch2, 1 hdc in same stitch, 2 hdc into each st around. SI st to join.

Row 3: Ch2. *1 hdc in the next st, 2hdc in the next.* Repeat from * to * and sl st to join.

Row 4: Ch2. 1 hdc in the next st, 2hdc in the next. *1 hdc, 1 hdc, 2hdc.* Repeat from * to * and sl st to join.

Row 5: Ch2, 1 hdc in each blo around and sl st to join.

Row 6-11: Ch2. 1 hdc in each st around and sl st to join and F.O.

Attach your 'topping' colour to any stitch.

Row 1: Ch2. 1 hdc in each st around. Sl st to join.

Row 2: Ch3. Working in the flo for this round; 3 dc into each st around. Sl st to join. FO.

Row 3: Re-attach the same colour yarn in the blo of Row 1.

Working in blo of Row

Chain 2, 1 hdc in each stitch. SI st to join.

Row 4: Working in both loops from now on: Ch2. *2 hdc in the next stitch, 1 hdc in the next.* Repeat from * to * all the way round and sl st to join.



Row 5-10: Ch2. 1 hdc in each stitch around. SI st to join. FO.

Make a chain using the 'cake' colour (your first yarn colour that you used) and make it long enough to go around the bag at least twice. Weave the chain in and out of the top row
