Crochet Granny Stitch Cowl

2 balls of <u>Magic Light Ice yarn in the rainbow colourway</u>
5.5 mm/I hook
Scissors, measuring tape and yarn needle
A couple of stitch markers <u>https://amzn.to/3LZJhdY</u>

- Foundation single crochet until your row is 30 inches long. Making sure your row isn't twisted, slip stitch to the first foundation single crochet to join.
- 2. Ch 1, (3 sc, ch 1) into the same stitch. *Skip 3 stitches, (3 hdc, ch 1) into the 4th chain* repeat from * to * to the end of the round. **DO NOT JOIN or TURN.**
- 3. Make sure your work is not twisted. (3 hdc, ch 1) into the **top of the first sc** from round 2. *(3 hdc, ch 1) into the next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * to end of the round.
- 4. *(3 hdc, ch1) into the next ch 1 space* repeat for the remainder of the project until you are 3 rounds short of the length you would like.

The next 3 rounds are optional.

If you do not want to do this step, skip it 😊

3hdc into the next ch 1 space repeat from * to * for another 3 rounds

To neaten off, work 1 round of single crochet.

Sew the first round together and sew in ends.
