

## Circle of hearts

Approximate size $14 \mathrm{~cm} \times 14 \mathrm{~cm} / 5.5$ inch $\times 5.5$ inch Red heart super saver
5.5 mm I hook

Tension normal to loose
MC - main colour
CC - contrast colour
Shell-3 dc

With MC
Magic circle or ch 4 and join with slip stitch to first ch to form a ring
Ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 * 3 dc , ch 1 * repeat * to * 4 more times for a total of 6 shells, ch 1, join, Finish off


Join CC into any ch 1 space (ch 3, 2dc, ch 1, 3 dc ) in ch 1 space (3dc, ch 1, 3 dc ) in each ch 1 space

The next round you will be going into the ch 1 spaces and the spaces between the shells Join MC into any ch 1 space (ch 3, 2dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same ch 1 space ( 3 dc , ch 1, 3dc) in next space, slip stitch into the next ch 1 space ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next space
*(3dc, ch 1, 3dc) in next ch 1 space, $3 d c$ into next space, 3 dc into next ch 1 space, 3 dc into next space* repeat from * to * Join to the top of the ch 3

The next round we will be crocheting into the stitches and the ch 1 spaces - I will refer to the ch 1 space as a stitch not a ch 1 space
Ch 3, dc into the next 11 stitches, hdc in next stitch, sc into next stitch, slip stitch into next, sc into next stitch, hdc into next stitch, dc into the next 12, sc into the next $12(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ ) into the next stitch (this is the point of the heart at the bottom) sc into the next 12 stitches

## Optional

Add a round of slip stitch
