

Crochet heart

Note: yarn can be substituted for a thinner weight yarn and smaller hook

Tension: tight

Red heart super saver worsted weight / 10 ply and a 4.25 mm / G hook

Sport weight / DK / 8ply and a 3.00 mm / D hook

Scissors

Yarn needle

Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch OR make a magic ring

- 1. Chain 3 (does not count as a stitch) 24 dc into ring, join with a slip stitch to the 1st dc
- 2. Skip 2 stitches, 9 dc into the next stitch, skip 2 stitches, slip stitch into the next stitch, skip 2 stitches, 9 dc into the next stitch, skip 2 stitches, slip stitch into the next stitch
- 3. Slip stitch in each stitch around until the point (bottom of heart) chain 1, slip stitch around until the dip (the low point between the 2 groups of 9dc's) tight slip stitch into the space that you slip stitched into from round 1, slip stitch until end of round and slip stitch to the first slip stitch and finish off. If you are sewing your heart to a project leave a 10 inch tail
