

Crochet Hook Case

EASY

Yarn - Main colour– 100 gms / 3.5oz

Contrast colour 20 gms

Crochet hook that is recommended for the yarn you have chosen

Scissors & Darning needle

US Terms are used in this pattern

DC - Double Crochet

SC - Single Crochet

HDC - Half Double Crochet

CH - Chain

ST - Stitch (s)

SL ST - Slip Stitch



You need to make two pieces 11 ½"/29cms high X 8 ½ "/21.5 cms OR the size you would like to make

Row 1: Make a slip knot and ch to your required length. 1dc in 3rd ch from hook, 1dc in every ch across.
Turn

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as your 1st stitch), 1dc in each stitch across, ch3, turn

Repeat row 2 until you reach your required height.

When you've finished both pieces sew in tail ends and now you're ready to sew pieces together.
You can either use the same color or use a contrast color.

You can whip stitch the edges together with darning needle or crochet them together. I find crocheting them together is much quicker and gives a neater edge.

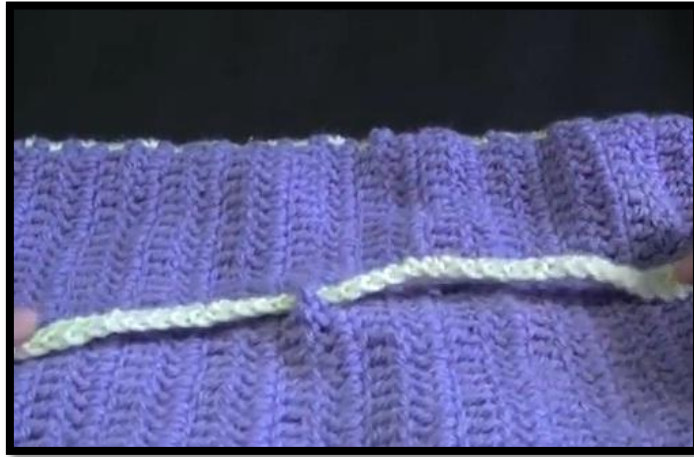
Insert your crochet hook in to the corner space making sure you get both layers. Sl st and ch1, working 1 row of single crochet evenly around the edge. When you get to the corners, do 3sc. Fasten off.

Make a tie for the outside of the case.

In the video I made my chain 17 ½ "/ 44.5cms long. I got this length by making a chain. Rolling up the crochet case and then wrap the chain around making sure i could tie a bow. If you need your a different length adjust the amount of chains

Note you can do any crochet stitch you like or use a piece of ribbon for the tie. If you choose a dc stitch, dc into the 4th chain from hook

Row 1: HDC in 3rd ch from the hook, and 1hdc across to the end. Fasten off and sew in the ends.



To secure your tie, find the middle of the outside of your case (see image above) and pull through one stitch with a crochet hook. Tie ends together and there's your finished crochet hook case roll.
