US stitches used

Slip stitch

Chain

Single crochet

Half double crochet

Double crochet

Treble crochet

Yarn can be any thickness

Large lips – Approximately 3.5 inch - I used worsted weight yarn and a 3.75mm/F hook

Small lips - I also used 8ply/Sports eight/Double knit yarn and a 2.75mm/C hook

Scissors and a yarn needle



Row 1

Chain 18, single crochet into 2^{nd} chain from the hook, half double crochet into the next chain – instead of me writing into the next stitch do this, into the next stitch do that, I will just type the stitch and that is what you do into the chain – each chain will have **1 stitch** until the last chain \odot
