US stitches used

Slip stitch

Chain

Single crochet

Half double crochet

Double crochet

Treble crochet

Yarn can be any thickness

Large - I used worsted weight yarn and a 3.75mm/F hook

Small - I also used 8ply/Sports eight/Double knit yarn and a 2.75mm/C hook

Scissors and a yarn needle



Row 1

Chain 19, single crochet into 2nd chain from the hook, half double crochet into the next chain – instead of me writing into the next stitch do this, into the next stitch do that, I will just type the stitch and that is what you do into the chain – each chain will have **1 stitch** until the last chain ©

Single crochet into last stitch, slip stitch to join, leaving a long tail if you need to sew your moustache onto a project or sew in any loose end



It is easy to adjust the amount of stiches on your moustache. Remember if you add a stitch to one side you have to add it to the other and also add that same amount to the beginning chain
