US terminology

Easy

See notes about yarn

Number 4 weight
yarn/Aran/10ply & a 11mm
hook

Number 3 weight yarn/DK8ply
yarn scraps & a 9mm hook

Scissors

Yarn needle that is small enough
to go through holes in buttons



Notes

Any thickness of yarn can be used, make sure you stick with the 1 thickness of yarn.

This project is made using 3 strands of yarn held together.

Chain as many chains as you want the width of your project.

1. Hdc into second ch from hook and each ch across, turn.
2. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into same stitch, hdc into each stitch across, on last stitch work through both loops, turn.
3. Repeat row 2 until you reach desired size.

Border

Evenly crochet around the outside of your project, putting 3 hdc into the corners.
