

Crochet Shower Luffa

Materials

2 yarns are held together for this project.

If you use 10ply (Worsted weight number/Aran) yarn, use 1 strand of yarn and recommended hook size.

2 x Cream [Clear as Cotton Maykr Yarn](#) 8ply (DK/Number 3 weight)

5mm/l hook

Yarn needle

1. Chain 8, join to 1st stitch with a slip stitch.

If you would like a loop to hang up your loofa, make a chain that is 8 inches long, slip stitch to the first chain to create a loop.

If you do not want a handle, do not make the chains.

Single crochet into the smaller circle until you can not fit anymore in it. Make sure you squish them up to fit in as many as possible.

If you made the hanging loop, place this to the back and join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet.

2. Chain 2, 2 half double crochets into the same stitch, 3 half double crochets in each stitch around, join with a slip to the top of the chain 2.
3. Chain 3, 2 double crochets into the same stitch, 3 double crochets into each stitch around. Join with a slip to the top of the chain 3.
4. Chain 3, 1 double crochet in each stitch around. Join with a slip to the top of the chain 3.
5. Cut yarn, finish off and sew in ends.
