1. Ch 15, slip stitch to the first stitch. Make a ch the length you want your wind spinner. I did mine 30 cm/12 inches long. Turn.
2. Sc into the 2nd ch and each ch across. Turn.
3. Ch 2 (counts as the first stitch), 2 hdc into the same stitch. 3hdc in each stitch across.

There are 2 options for the last row

Option 1: 2 dc into each stitch across.

Option 2: (2dc, ch3, slip stitch to first ch) in each stitch across. Ch 2 and slip stitch to the last can
