

Crochet Easy Chain Scarf - Easy to make any length

2 x strands of worsted weight yarn and a 7mm hook

OR



2 x strands of 8ply/Double Knit yarn and a 5mm hook

Scissors

Yarn needle

Stitch marker



Notes

- We do not count the chains in this project
- A 50 inch long chain will make a scarf that can be doubled around your neck. If you would like the scarf shorter adjust the length of the chain and use this measurement throughout
- 1. Make a chain 50 inches/125cm long (if you are using 2 x strands of worsted weight yarn and a 7mm hook you will need approximately 140 chains. If you are using 2 x strands of 8ply/Double Knit yarn and a 5mm hook it will be approximately 180 chains) join with a slip stitch into 1st chain. (It does not matter if the chain twists with this project)
- 2. Chain 1, single crochet into the same stitch, single crochet into the next 9 stitches, place a stitch marker at the bottom edge of your project, this will help you know which way up your crochet should be when you come around to the next row. Make another length of chain stitches until the length matches the first one, join with a slip stitch to the first single crochet
- 3. Slip stitch into the next 9 stitches, make chain stitches until the chain is 50 inches/125cm join with a slip stitch to the first slip stitch
- 4. Repeat rows 2 and 3 for remainder of scarf until desired thickness
