

Traditional Granny Square

NOTE: If the square is not lying flat then do a chain 2 in the corners instead of chain 1. Also if it's still not flat after you have done that then try adding a Chain 1 between each other 3 Double Crochet section as well.

Begin with a Magic Ring or Chain 4 and Slip Stitch to join.

1: Chain 3, 2 Double Crochet into ring, Chain 1, *3 Double Crochet into ring, Chain 1* Repeat *to* 2 more times. Join to top of Chain 3 with a slip stitch.

If you are using the one colour throughout then move onto round 2, if not then fasten off here and sew in your ends.

2: If you are using a new colour then join with a Slip Stitch to any corner. If using the same colour you will slip stitch in next 2 stitches and into chain 1 space.

Chain 3, 2 Double Crochet, Chain 1, 3 Double Crochet into same space, *3 Double Crochet, Chain 1, 3 Double Crochet into next space* Repeat *to* 2 more times. Join to top of Chain 3 with a slip stitch. If you are using the one colour throughout then move onto round 2, if not then fasten off here and sew in your ends.

3: If you are using a new colour then join with a Slip Stitch to any corner. If using the same colour you will slip stitch in next 2 stitches and into chain 1 space.

Chain 3, 2 Double Crochet, Chain 1, 3 Double Crochet into same space, 3 Double Crochet into next space *3 Double Crochet, Chain 1, 3 Double Crochet into next corner space, 3 Double Crochet into next space* Repeat *to* 2 more times. Join to top of Chain 3 with a slip stitch.

If you are using the one colour throughout then move onto round 2, if not then fasten off here and sew in your ends.

4: If you are using a new colour then join with a Slip Stitch to any corner. If using the same colour you will slip stitch in next 2 stitches and into chain 1 space.

Chain 3, 2 Double Crochet, Chain 1, 3 Double Crochet into same space, 3 Double Crochet into next space, 3 Double Crochet into next space *3 Double Crochet, Chain 1, 3 Double Crochet into next corner space, 3 Double Crochet into next space, 3 Double Crochet into next space * Repeat *to* 2 more times. Join to top of Chain 3 with a slip stitch. Fasten off.

Continue like this until your square is as large as you would like it to be.
