

Scrap - Tastic Finger-less Gloves Recipe This is a guide and not a step by step written pattern Designed by Clare Sullivan

Red Heart Super saver in various colours – I used hot red, pumpkin, bright yellow and spring green 5 mm/ H hook
3.5 mm/F hook
Scissors
Yarn needle
Elastic for last round on wrist

My granny squares are 4 inches across

- Make 4 traditional granny squares using the half double crochet instead of the double crochet, this
 will give you smaller spaces and be warmer to wear
- I used chain 2 in the corners and none on the straight section
- When you have your granny squares finished, lay one on top of the other with wrong sides facing, and sew up one side the whole way and the side leaving a thumb hole
- Attach yarn around bottom edge, chain 1, half double crochet into each stitch around, join, change colour
- Chain 1, half double crochet in each stitch around, join, change colour
- Repeat last round 3 times
- Cut of a length of elastic that fits around your wrist + 2 inches, tie up the size you need and with the 3.5mm hook crochet around the elastic with a half double crochet round crochet over the elastic like you would crochet over a tail by laying it on top of the previous round, this will trap the elastic in the stiches
- Finish off and sew in ends
- With 3.5mm hook work a round of half double crochet around the top of the gloves, finish off and sew in ends

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
