## Granny Stitch Hat <br> Designed by Clare Sullivan Video tutorial -

The following measurement are the hats UN - STRETCHED - you will get about $2 \mathrm{~cm}-3 \mathrm{~cm}$ stretch on the sizes larger than the large doll


## Small doll

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 4 inch/10cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - 3.5 inch/ 9 cm circumference
Medium doll
Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 8 inch/20 cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - $6 \frac{1}{4}$ inch $/ 16 \mathrm{~cm}$ circumference
Large doll
Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 11 inch / 28 cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - $101 / 4 / 26 \mathrm{~cm}$ circumference

## Preemie - Newborn

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 15 inch / 38 cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - 12.5 inch / 32 cm circumference
3-6 month
Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 17.5 inch / 44 cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - 16 inch / 40 cm circumference
X-large or slouch hat - adult
Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 21 inch / 53 cm circumference
Large adult
8ply/DK yarn - 22 inch / 56 cm circumference

## 2-3 year old

8ply/DK yarn - 19 inch / 48 cm circumference

## Small Adult/teen

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 19inch / 50 cm circumference

Red heart super saver
$5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{H}$ hook
4mm / G hook smaller hook for slouch hat
Scissors
Yarn needle
Shells - 3dc
Gauge 3 inch $\times 3$ inch $=3$ groups of 3 double crochet stitches $\times 6$ rows

- If you want to change colour for the next round, ignore the slip stitching, finish off and join new colour in next space
- You can use a magic circle instead of the ch 4 and join


## Small doll

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 4 inch/10cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - 3.5 inch/9 cm circumference
Magic ring or ch 4 and join
1 - Ch 3, 2 dc into ring, ch 1*3dc, ch1* repeat from * to * 2 more times -4 shells
2 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into chain 1 space (ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into same ch 1 space, 3 dc into each ch 1 space. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the beginning ch 3
3 - Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc into each stitch around, slip stitch to the first sc
4 - Repeat round 3
Finish off and sew in any loose ends

## Medium doll

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 8 inch/20 cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - $61 / 4$ inch $/ 16 \mathrm{~cm}$ circumference
Magic ring or ch 4 join
1 - Ch 3, working into ring, $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,{ }^{*} 3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1^{*}$ repeat 2 more times, join with a slip stitch to the top of the beginning ch 3 - you will have 4 groups of 3 double crochet
2 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space (ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into same ch 1 space *( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3$ dc) into
next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
3 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space, * 3 dc into each space around * repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
4 - Repeat round 3
5 - Ch 1, sc into each stitch around, join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
6 - repeat round 5
Finish off and sew in ends

## Large doll

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 11 inch / 28 cm circumference
8ply/DK yarn - $101 / 4 / 26 \mathrm{~cm}$ circumference
Magic ring or ch 4 join
1 - Ch 3, working into ring, 2 dc, ch 1, *3 dc, ch 1* repeat 2 more times, join with a slip stitch to the top of the beginning ch 3 - you will have 4 groups of 3 double crochet
2 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space (ch 3,2 dc, ch 1,3 dc) into same ch 1 space *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) into
next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
3 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space *(3 dc, ch 1,3 dc) into next space. 3 dc into next ch 1 space* repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

4 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3 , 2 dc into same ch 1 space, * 3 dc into each space around * repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

5-9 repeat round 4
10 - Ch 1, sc into each stitch around, join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
Finish off and sew in ends

## Preemie

8ply/DK yarn - 12.5 inch / 32 cm circumference

## Newborn

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 15 inch / 38 cm circumference
Magic ring or chain 4 join
1 - Ch 3, working into ring, 2 dc, ch 1, *3 dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * 3 more times, join with a slip stitch to the top of the beginning ch 3 - you will have 5 groups of 3 double crochet

2 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc into same ch 1 space *(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) into
next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
3 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space *( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into next space. 3 dc into next ch 1 space* repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3 4 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3 , 2 dc into same ch 1 space, * 3 dc into each space around * repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

5-10 Repeat round 4
11 - Ch 1, sc into each stitch around, join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
12 - Repeat round 11
Finish off and sew in ends

## 3 month

8ply/DK yarn - 16 inch / 40 cm circumference

## 6 month

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 17.5 inch / 44 cm circumference
Magic ring or ch 4 join
1 - Ch 3, working into ring, 2 dc, ch 1, *3 dc, ch 1* repeat from * to * 4 more times, join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3 - you will have 6 groups of 3 dc
2 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ into same ch 1 space * ( 3 dc , ch 1,3 dc) into next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

3 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space, ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space $*(3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into next space, 3 dc into next ch 1 space* repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3 4 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3 , 2 dc into same ch 1 space, * 3 dc into each space around * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

5-11 Repeat round 4
12-15 Ch 1, sc into each stitch around, join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
Finish off and sew in ends

## 2-3 year old

8ply/DK yarn - 19 inch / 48 cm circumference

## Small Adult/teen

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 19inch / 50 cm circumference

Magic ring or ch 4 join
1 - Ch 3, working into ring, $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, * 3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1^{*}$ repeat from * to * 3 more times, join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3 - you will have 5 groups of 3 double crochet
2 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc into same ch 1 space *( 3 dc , ch 1, 3 dc) into
next ch1 space* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
3 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into next space. 3 dc into next ch 1 space* repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
4 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same space, 3 dc into the next ch 1 space ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into next space *3 dc into next space, 3 dc into next ch 1 space, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into next space* repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

5 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space * 3 dc into each space around * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

6-15 Repeat round 5
16-19 Ch 1, sc into each stitch around. Slip stitch to the first sc
Finish off and sew in ends

## X-large or slouch hat - adult

Worsted/Aran/10ply yarn - 21 inch / 53 cm circumference

## Large adult

8ply/DK yarn - 22 inch / 56 cm circumference
Ch 4, join (blue hat)
1 -Ch 3, working into ring, $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,{ }^{*} 3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1^{*}$ repeat from * to * 4 more times, join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3 - you will have 6 groups of 3 double crochet
2- Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1,3 dc into same ch 1 space * ( 3 dc , ch 1,3 dc) into next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3

3 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space *(3dc, ch 1,3 dc) into next space. 3 dc into next ch 1 space* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3 4 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same space, 3 dc into the next ch 1 space ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into next space *3 dc into next space, 3 dc into next ch 1 space, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into next space* repeat from *to * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
5 - Slip stitch across 2 stitches and into ch 1 space. Ch 3,2 dc into same ch 1 space * 3 dc into each space around * join with a slip stitch to the beginning ch 3
6-14 Repeat round 5
15 - Ch 1 , sc into the same stitch as ch 1 , sc into each stitch around, join with a slip stitch to $1^{\text {st }}$ sc If you are making a slouch hat and need to make the brim smaller to fit head, change to a smaller hook OR d o 1 round of decreasing every 5 or so stitches - try hat on after decrease round to make sure you have e nough
If you are making just a normal hat (not slouch) continue with the same crochet hook 16-19 Repeat round 15
Finish off and sew in ends
