Yarn of your choice with recommended crochet hook (see yarn label)

Scissors

Yarn needle

Magic Ring or ch4 and slip stitch to join.

1: Ch3, 2 Dc into the ring, *Ch3, 3dc into ring* Repeat *to*once more, ch3 slip stitch to top of ch3 to join. Close up magic ring.

2: Slip stitch into the top of the next 2 stitches and into ch 3 space, ch3 (2dc, ch3, 3dc into the same space) ch2, *3dc, ch3, 3dc into the next ch3 space, ch2 * Repeat from *to* once more, slip stitch to top of ch3 to join.

3: Slip stitch into the top of the next 2 stitches, ch3 (2dc, ch3, 3dc) into the same space, ch2, 3dc into next ch2 space, ch2 *(3dc, ch3, 3dc into same space) ch2, 3dc into the next ch2 space, ch2* Repeat *to* once more, slip stitch into top ch3 to join.

4: Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc into the next 2 stitches, sc into ch3 space, ch 7 (change this number of chains to fit your toe) sc into same space. Sc into each stitch across to the next chain space, 2sc into ch space, continue sc in each stitch and in each ch around. Slip stitch into sc to join. Fasten off.

Reattach yarn into the middle stitch of a corner. Chain a length as long as you like to tie your sandal on. I made mine about 30 inches long. Fasten off. Do the same for the remaining corner.
