

Hooded Cowl Designed by Clare Sullivan Video tutorial – US terms





Red heart super saver Colour - Buff 4 ounce / 150 grams Warm brown 1 ounce / 50 grams Scissors Yarn needle Tape measure 2 stitch markers

Cowl Measure the head that you want to make it for Add 1 inch or 3 cm to that measurement Example – 58 cm + 3 cm = 61 cm

With buff make your chain as long as your final measurement Being careful not to twist, join with a slip stitch to the first ch

- 1. Ch 3 (does not count as a stitch) dc into same stitch, dc into each ch around, slip stitch to the 1st dc
- 2. Repeat last round for length of project Finish off and sew in ends

- Count the amount of stiches you have and divide by 3 Example
 - 100 stitches divide by 3 = 33 (round to nearest number)
- From where you finished off count 33 stitches to the left and place a stitch marker
- From where you finished off count 33 stitches to the **righ**t and place a stitch marker You will be crocheting into the stitches in the larger section between the stitch markers

Join yarn into the right hand (if you are right handed/left if you are left handed) marked stitch

- 1. Ch 3, dc in each stitch across until you reach second stitch marker, turn
- 2. Repeat last row for as long as you need it (see measurement guide at end of pattern)

Ears Make 2

- 1. 5 sc into ring, turn
- 2. Ch 1 (doesn't not count as a stitch here and throughout pattern) 2 sc into same stitch, 2 sc into each stitch, turn
- 3. Ch 1, sc into same stitch, 2 sc into next stitch *sc into next stitch, 2 sc into next stitch* repeat from * to * across, turn
- 4. Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc in next stitch, 2 sc in next * sc into the next 2 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch* repeat from * to * across, turn
- 5. Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc in next 2 stitches * sc into the next 3 stitches, 2 sc in next stitch* repeat from * to * across, turn
- 6. Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc in each stitch across
- 7. Repeat 6
- 8. Slip stitch across

Inner section of ear

Make 2 – follow rows 1 – 3, skip 4,5,6,7, and then complete row 8 Fold ears so that the 2 straight edges meet and sew up Using video or photo as a guide sew on ears
