

## Crochet I-cord Written by Clare Sullivan

Icords can be used for a variety of projects – bags, hats, sweaters and much more Video tutorial -



Materials
Crochet Hook
Yarn, color of your choice
Scissors
Wool needle

## Icord instructions:

Tip: to tighten the icord, pull up on 2<sup>nd</sup> loop on hook and then pull 3<sup>rd</sup> loop as you work.

- 1. Ch 3, go into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, pull up loop, go into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch, pull up loop. Remove 1<sup>st</sup> two loops from hook (closest to the tip of the hook) and hold them. Hang on tight because the will try to get away on you ©
- 2. Ch 1, put next loop you're holding back on hook, ch 1, put last loop you're holding back on hook, ch 1. You should end up with 3 loops on your hook.
- Repeat steps 1 & 2 until you reach the desired length.
- Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops to fasten off. Weave in ends.
