

Linda's Cable Stitch Hat Designed in memory of my mum Linda Designed by Clare Sullivan Video tutorial – <u>https://youtu.be/3kclqHLPTCo</u>



DK/8ply with a 3.5mm hook

OR

Worsted weight/10ply with a 5.5mm hook


fdc -foundation double crochet

fptr – front post treble crochet

fpdc – front post double crochet

dcdec - double crochet decrease

- 1. Leaving a 4 inch tail for sewing gap shut, fdc in multiples of 4+1, join to first dc (not ch 3)
- ch 3, skip 2 stitches, 1 fptr into the next 2 stitches, 1 fptr into the first skipped stitch, 1 fptr into the 2nd skipped stitch, dc into the next available stitch (see image, the stitch marked with the box is the fptr) and remaining stiches, join with a slip stitch to the first stitch not ch 3



- 3. ch3, fpdc around next 4 stitches, dc in each remaining stitch, join with a slip stitch to the first stitch not ch 3
- 4. Repeat 2 and 3 for height of hat
 Following measurements are a guide only
 Adult 14 cm
 Child 12 cm
 Baby 10 cm
 Continuing with cable pattern
- Work cable *dc into the next 2 stitches, dcdec* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the first fptr
- Work cable, dc in each remaining stitch
- Work cable *dc, dcdec* repeat from * to * join with a slip stitch to the first fptr
- Work cable, dc in each remaining stitch
- Work cable, dcdec in every stitch
- Work cable, 1 dc in each remaining stitch
- Leaving a 6 inch tail, fasten off, gather stitches
- Sew beginning gap shut
