50 grams of cotton 10 ply/Worsted weight


4.5mmm hook

Yarn needle and scissors

- 1. Ch 31. Sc into the 2nd ch and each ch across. Do not turn
- 2. Ch 1, Into the side of the last sc (see image) work (sc, ch 1) x 3
- 3. Working down the other side of the ch (sc, ch 1) into the first ch, *skip 1 ch and (sc, ch 1) into the next ch*


repeat from * to * across. Into the last sc work (sc, ch 1) x 3 Continue working pattern across the second side DO NOT JOIN

4. Continue working skip 1 ch and (sc, ch 1) into the next ch for about 9 rounds




finish round off half way through a round so that the yarn finishes in the correct place when folded (see last photo)

Turn sideways so you are looking at the end –see below



Fold edge down – see next 2 images







You have enough rounds when the edges meet
