

## Crochet pin cushion Designed by Clare Sullivan Video tutorial – <a href="http://youtu.be/FKuBSUAHn5U">http://youtu.be/FKuBSUAHn5U</a> US Terminology used in this pattern



Red heart super saver scraps – approx. 60 grams / 2 ounces

Stuffing – I used really small off cuts of yarn – you can also use toy stuffing

4 mm / G hook – you need tight tension

Scissors

Yarn needle

2 ½ inch buttons

1 meter/ 1 yard piece of yarn to match button

NOTE: I had a heap of scraps no longer than 1 meter/1yard long. I tied them together instead of joining in the new colour as I went <sup>(1)</sup> I do not normally tie knots in crochet but this was an exception <sup>(2)</sup> I sat there 1 night and tied all my scraps together and then rewound them into a ball






## Make 2

- 1. Magic ring or Ch 4 and join with a slip stitch to the first stitch, ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) 8 sc into ring DO NOT JOIN
- 2. 1 sc (place stitch marker into this stitch) 1 sc into same stitch, 2 sc into each stitch round, stopping at the stitch before the marker
- 3. 1 sc into next stitch (place stitch marker into this stitch) 2 sc into next stitch\* 1 sc into next stitch, 2 sc into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around
- 4. 1 sc into next stitch (place stitch marker into this stitch) 1 sc into next stitch, 2 sc into next stitch\* 1 sc into next 2 stitches, 2 sc into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around

I will not tell you to move the stitch marker anymore © You can make the pin cushion as wide as you want to

- \*1 sc into the next 3 stitches, 2 sc into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around
- \*1 sc into the next 4 stitches, 2 sc into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around
- \*1 sc into the next 5 stitches, 2 sc into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around
- \*1 sc into the next 6 stitches, 2 sc into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around
- Leaving a 12 inch tail finish off
- Placing 2 sides together with the ends on the inside, sew around the outside to close up seam REMEMBER TO LEAVE A 2 INCH hole for inserting the stuffing
- Stuff pin cushion and sew up remaining seam
- You can sew the button like I did or sew the button on after the segments each segment is worked into the middle – use the video as a guide starting at 26 minute.30 second mark
