

# CROCHET POPCORN FLOWER GRANNY

Red heart super saver worsted weight  
5.00 mm / H hook  
Yarn needle  
Scissors



## Beginning popcorn/ beg PC

Ch 3, 4 dc into same stitch, pull out hook, put hook into top of ch 3, put loop back on hook, pull through loop and pull snug

## Popcorn/PC

5 dc into same stitch, pull out hook, put hook into top of 1<sup>st</sup> dc, put loop back on hook, pull through loop and pull snug

## NOTE: do not work your chains tight between the popcorns

1. With contrast color, make a magic circle or chain 4 and join. Beg PC, ch 2 \*PC, ch 2\* repeat around until you have 6 popcorns including beg PC, join into the 1<sup>st</sup> ch 2 space. Finish off
2. With main color, join into any ch 2 space, ch 3, 2 dc into same space, ch 1, 3 dc into the same space \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) into the next ch 2 space\* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3. Finish off

## NOTE: do not work your chains tight between the popcorns

3. With contrast color, join to any ch 1 space beg \*PC into ch 1 space, ch 3, PC into the space between the next 2 group of 3d's – If you have made a granny square before its where you would put your group of 3dc's on any straight section – ch 3\* repeat fro \* to \* around. Join into the 1<sup>st</sup> ch 3 space. Finish off
4. Join main color to and ch 3 space. (Ch 3, 2 dc into same space, ch 2, 3 dc) into the same space, 3 dc into the next 2 ch 3 spaces \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) into the next ch 3 space, 3 dc into the next 2 ch 3 spaces \* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3.
5. Slip stitch across to ch 2 space (Ch 3, 2 dc into same space, ch 2, 3 dc) into the same space, 3 dc into the next 3 spaces \*(3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) into the next ch 2 space, 3 dc into the next 3 spaces \* repeat from \* to \* around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3. Finish off and sew in ends
