

# **Crochet Pumpkin Garland**

Pumpkins can also be used as embellishments

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Add faces for extra cuteness ©

- Worsted weight yarn in pumpkin colour
- Worsted weights yarn for stem and chain colour
- 5.5mm hook
- OR
- Yarn and hook of your choice
- Note: The chain 3 does NOT counted as a stitch at the beginning of a round

## Make a Magic Ring

Round 1: chain 3 (NOT counted as a stitch) 11 double crochet's into ring, ignoring the chain 3, join with a slip stitch to the 1<sup>st</sup> double crochet – You will have 12 stitches

Round 2: chain3 (NOT counted as a stitch) 2 double crochet's in same stitch, 2 double crochet's in the next 8 stitches, 2 half double crochets in the next stitch, 2 single crochets in the next stitch, 2 half double



crochets in the next stitch, ignoring the chain 3, join with a slip stitch to the 1<sup>st</sup> double crochet – You will have 24 stiches

Round 3: chain 1, single crochet in the same stitch,\*1 single crochet into the next stitch, 2 single crochets on the next stitch\* repeat from \*to \* until you have 6 stitches left, slip stitch (not to tight) in the last 6 stitches. Slip stitch to the 1<sup>st</sup> single crochet to join. Fasten off and weave/sew in tails

The flat section is the top of the pumpkin. Attach stem colour yarn to the middle stitch of the flat section (see image below)



#### Stem - Variation 1

Chain 3, double crochet in same stitch, double crochet in the next stitch, chain 3, slip stitch into the same stitch as the previous double crochet

### Stem - Variation 2

Chain 4, treble crochet in same stitch, treble crochet in the next stitch, chain 4, slip stitch into the same stitch as the previous double crochet

#### String

You can make the string any length you like, I use 20 chains in between each pumpkin If you would like to make a loop on the end to hang up your garland (see image below) leave a length of 20cm/10 inch before you make your slip knot





Chain 20, slip stitch into the top of the stem between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> double crochet (see image below)



Repeat the chain 20 and slip stitching to the stem until you have joined all your pumpkins together

Chain 20 and finish off leaving a 20cm/10 inch before you cut your yarn

Tie a loop in the ends of the yarn and sew in ends
