

Scrap-tastic project bag Designed by Clare Sullivan Video tutorial – <u>https://youtu.be/ITCdFoYFThk</u> Contains photos from video tutorial

Blue bag – 10 inches wide

1 x 100 grams Red Heart shimmer yarn and 4mm / g hook

Rainbow bag – 17 inches wide

- 4 x 100 grams dk of your choice and LOTS of scraps
- Scissors and yarn needle
- 4 stitch markers

NOTE: When I made the rainbow bag I used 4 strands of yarn at once - I used 2 strands of black DK and 2 strands of colour, I tried to use the same shades of colour

Bag

- Ch 35, 3 hdc into the 2nd ch from hook, 1 hdc into each ch (3 hdc, place maker in last stitch just made, 3 hdc into last ch) Working down the other side of the chain, 1 hdc into each ch, 3 hdc into last ch, place a maker into last stitch made
- 2. 3 hdc into next stitch, 1 hdc in each stitch until you get to marked stitch, 3 hdc into marked stitch **and** next stitch, hdc into each stitch until marked stitch, 3 hdc into marked stitch
- 3. Hdc into each stitch around
- Repeat 3 until desired length remember your handles will add a little bit of length to your bag
 To finish off make sure you finish off on the edge of the bag lay bag flat and make sure your last stitch is at the edge see below single crochet into the next stitch and slip stitch into the next stitch







Fold bag in half and place a place a stitch marker at the halfway point, do the same on the back





Count 8 stitches – do the same for the back -see below



It should look like this



NOTE: You will now have 17 stitches for the handles including the marked stitches Handles

- Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) sc dec in each stitch until you get to the stitch marker *ch 34, skip 17 stitches (these are the stitches in between the stitch markers) sc dec into the next stitch marked stitch and each stitch until you get to the next stitch maker. Repeat from * to and join with a slip stitch to the first sc
- 2. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) sc into each stitch of bag and work 34 sc around the chain 34 handle loop, join with a slip stitch to the first sc
- 3. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) sc into each stitch, join with a slip stitch to the first sc, finish off and sew in ends
