

Slanted shell stitch Designed by Clare Sullivan Pattern can be used for scarf or afghan

Materials

Any yarn can be used for this project

Hook recommended for yarn

Scissors and yarn needle

- I did 2 rows cream and 1 row variegated and then repeated throughout
- This patterns also looks great if you change colour each row
- Try not to work your chain 3 to loose, you could also change it to a chain 2

Multiple of 4 plus 5

Row 1 - 3 dc into the 5th chain from hook *skip 3 chain (1 single crochet, chain 3, 3 double crochet) into the next chain repeat from * to last 4 chains, miss 3 chains, 1 double crochet into last chain, turn

Row 2 - Chain 4, 3 double crochet into 4th chain from hook *skip (3 double crochet)** (1 single crochet ch 3, 3 double crochet) into next chain space (this is the chain 3 from the previous row), repeat form * to end, ending last repeat at ** 1 double crochet into the last chain space, turn
