

Stitch sampler cowl

DK/ply yarn 60 cm around and 35 cm high

Worsted weight /10 ply yarn 70cm around and 45 cm high

**US** terminology

Easy+

Colour A - light grey

Colour B - dark grey

Colour C - blue

4mm /G hook for DK/8ply yarn or 5.5mm I hook for worsted weight/10 ply yarn

Yarn needle, 1 stitch marker and scissors

## Notes

- We turn at the end of each round
- 1. RIGHT SIDE Ch 90 (if you want to make it longer/shorter add/minus multiples of 2) and join to make a continuous circle, ch 2, dc in next ch and each ch around, join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 2 place stitch marker around the post of any stitch to mark the right side TURN
- 2. Wrong side Ch 2 (does not count as a stitch) \*fpdc, bpdc \* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch to first fpdc, TURN
- 3. Ch 2 (does not count as a stitch) \*bpdc (around stitch and ch 2 below), fpdc \* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch to first bpdc, TURN
- 4. Ch 2, dc in each stitch around, join with s slip stitch to top of ch 2 TURN
- 5. Repeat 4 dc round
- 6. Repeat 4 dc round
- 7. Repeat 4 dc round
- 8. Repeat 4 dc round
- 9. Repeat 4 dc round



The next round is worked on the **WRONG** side of the work (remember how we used our trusty stitch marker to mark the right side ©) if you have changed the amount of rows you will need to make sure you work the next round on the **wrong** side because the pretty part of the stitch is the back of it

- 10. Change to colour B ch 1, hdc in the same stitch as the ch 1, hdc around the post of the hdc you just made
  \*skip a stitch, hdc in the next stitch, hdc around the post of the hdc you just made\* repeat from \* to \*
  around, join with a slip stitch to the first hdc TURN
- 11. Change to colour A and repeat 4 dc round
- 12. Change to colour B repeat 10 hdc round
- 13. Change to colour A repeat 4 dc round
- 14. Repeat 4 dc round
- 15. Repeat 4 dc round
- 16. Repeat 4 dc round
- 17. Repeat 4 dc round
- 18. Change to colour B repeat 4 dc round
- 19. Change to colour A repeat 4
- 20. Change to colour B repeat 4
- 21. Change to colour A repeat 4
- 22. Repeat 4
- 23. Change to colour C ch 3, dc into the stitch before the ch 3, working in normal direction, skip a stitch (not the ch 3, the empty stitch) dc in the next, dc in the skipped stitch
  - \*skip a stitch, dc in the next, dc in the skipped stitch\* repeat around and join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch 3, TURN
- 24. Repeat 23 cross stitch round
- 25. Repeat 23 cross stitch round
- 26. Repeat 23 cross stitch round
- 27. Repeat 23 cross stitch round
- 28. Change to colour A repeat 4 dc round
- 29. Repeat 2 fpdc and bpd round
- 30. Repeat 3 bpdc, fpdc
- 31. Repeat 2 fpdc, bpdc

Sew in ends
