

Unforgettable Scarf

Approx. 230 gms / 8.1 oz Red heart super saver yarn in turqua

OR

180 grms Unforgettable in Tidal

Stitch marker

Yarn needle

Scissors

NOTE: stitch marker is used to remind us what side of the scarf we do the increasing – 1 side of your scarf will be straight and the other will increase slowing with each row

NOTE: you can replace the Sc, ch 1 with a ch 3 if preferred

Increasing

- 1. Ch 4, 2 dc into 1st chain, turn 3 stitches
- 2. Sc, ch1 (place stitch marker on the side of the sc the outside edge of your scarf) dc into **same** stitch, dc into each stitch across
- 3. Sc, ch 1, dc into each stitch

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 44 rows or until width you want your scarf (mine is 8 ½ inches or 22 cm)

I had to do 56 rows with the RH Boutique Unforgettable yarn

Middle section

Sc, ch 1, dc into each stitch

Repeat last row for 16 rows (if you use a different amount of rows it must end on the side opposite the stitch marker

Decreasing

- 1. Sc, ch 1, dc into each stitch, working a dc decrease into the last 2 stitches
- 2. Sc, ch 1, dc into each stitch
- 3. Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 3 stitches left

Edging

Working along the side that has the increases and decreases

Option 1

Full edging - solid blue scarf

Ch 10, slip stitch into 4th ch from hook, 15 sc into loop, join with slip stitch to 1st sc, ch 6, slip stitch into next space repeat from * to * but this time slip stitch into the small hole – this is the dc stitch from one of the rows

Repeat this all the way long this side of scarf, finish off and sew in ends

Option 2

Lighter edging - multi colour scarf

Ch 10, slip stitch into 4th ch from hook, 15 sc into loop, join with slip stitch to 1st sc, ch 6, slip stitch into next space repeat from * to * all the way long this side of scarf, finish off and sew in ends
