

Breezy Shawl

Neck scarf

100 grams / 3.5 oz - Red heart super saver blue

6.5 mm hook

1 x ½ inch button

Shawl

2 x 2.5 / 70 grams Red Heart Boutique Midnight – Radiant

7 mm hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

Note:

V st - (dc, ch 1, dc) into same stitch

1. Make a magic ring, ch 3, V-st, ch 2, V-st, dc, turn
2. Ch 3, V-st into space between 1st and 2nd stitch, (V-st, ch 2, V-st) into ch 2 space, (V-st, dc) into space between second last and last stitch, turn

3. Ch 3, V-st into space between 1st and 2nd stitch, V-st into space between next 2 V-st's (V-st, ch 2, V-st) into ch 2 space, V-st into space between next 2 V-st's, (V-st, dc) into space between 2nd last and last stitch, turn
4. Ch 3, V-st into space between 1st and 2nd stitch * V-st into space between the next 2 V-st's* repeat from * to * once more (V-st, ch 2, V-st) into ch 2 space, repeat from * to * twice more (V-st, dc) into space between 2nd last and last stitch, turn

Repeat row 4 – NOTE: each row will gain 1 more space on each side of shawl between the V-sts

Neck scarf - repeat row 4 until you have a total of 16 rows

Shawl – repeat row 4 until you have a total of 25 rows

****Shawl edging only – Go straight to row 3**

1. Ch 1 *sc into same stitch, sc into each stitch and ch 1 space across* 3 sc into the ch 2 corner, repeat from * to * across, turn
2. Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc into next stitch *ch 1, skip a stitch, sc into the next 2 stitches* repeat from * to * to the end of the row, turn
3. Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc into next stitch, sc into ch 1 space *ch 3, slip stitch to 1st ch, sc into the next 2s stitches, sc into ch 1 space* repeat form * to * around, sc in the last 4 stitches

Optional

Sc along top edge of shawl/neck scarf, placing 2 or 3 sc in each space

Neck scarf

Sew button to the beginning of the row
